



Partners in Ministry Guidelines for Manna/Food Bags & Hygiene Kits

Assembly Instructions for Manna/Food Bags

Pack a one-gallon size re-sealable bag with items such as:

- Crackers (peanut butter, cheese, etc.)
- Granola Bars
- Tuna in pouches
- Anything in pop top cans, Vienna sausages and canned fruit, for example
- Plastic spoon(s)/fork(s)
- Fruit snacks
- Beef jerky
- Nuts
- Protein drinks
- Chewing gum
- Do not include money but feel free to add a note of encouragement

Assembly Instructions for Hygiene Kits

Materials

- **One hand towel (15 x 25 -17 x 27 inches)**
 - No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels
- **One washcloth**
- **One comb**
 - Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth
 - No pocket combs or picks
 - Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth
- **One toenail or fingernail clipper**
 - No emery boards or metal nail files

- **Bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger)**
 - No Ivory or Jergen's soap
 - Do not remove from packaging
- **One adult toothbrush**
 - Do not remove from packaging
 - Personal advertising not acceptable
- **10 adhesive bandages (3/4 by 3 inches)**
 - Common household bandages acceptable
- **One one-gallon size re-sealable bag**

Assembly Directions

- Lay hand towel flat on a table.
- Lay the washcloth in the center of the hand towel.
- Place all remaining items on top of the washcloth (except the plastic bag).
- Fold the sides of the hand towel to cover the items.
- Grasp the bundle tightly and roll over the remainder of the towel.
- Place the tightly rolled bundle in the plastic bag, remove air, and seal.

Important Notes

- All items must be new.
- Do not wash any items as they will no longer be considered new.
- Do not include money but feel free to add a note of encouragement.
